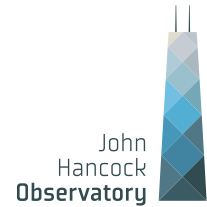


Skyscraper Scavenger Hunt

4. What is the name of one of the original architects of John Hancock Center?

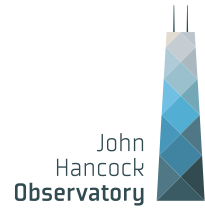
