Overview

John Hancock Observatory, one of Chicago's most visited tourist attractions, has launched a state-of-the-art synthetic ice skating rink more than 1,000 feet up on the 94th floor of John Hancock Center. This rink is the perfect place to host your birthday party or get together.

Size

900 square feet (83.6 square meters) or 20 ft. by 45 ft.

Hours

Open for Birthday Parties January 1, through April 8, 2012, from 9:00 am to 11:00 pm – additional hours available upon request.

Cost

Price: \$45.00 – \$50.00 per person – Minimum of 10 guests

- 25 minutes on the ice – \$45.00 per person
- 50 minutes on the ice – \$50.00 per person
- VIP Fast Pass entrance to Skating in the Sky
- Two tables reserved in the Lavazza Espresso Café
- 1 Kids box lunch (Sandwich, Bottled Water, Chips, Gelato)
- Custom John Hancock Center cake – serves up to 20 people

20 guests will get you exclusive access to the entire rink, based on availability. Skate rental is included in the price per person. Custom cake can be made to order. 4 different sandwich options. 50% deposit is required to confirm reservation.

More than an Alternative

The synthetic ice is more than an alternative to the real thing it's the closest thing to real ice without the water:

- Skaters feel more confident on it and learn to skate more quickly because they have more stability
- Conventional ice loses gliding ability of up to 10% in only 60 to 90 minutes. Our "ice" doesn't.
- No resurfacing means more "ice time" because the rink never goes out of use.
- With a shore D hardness of 66, or less than a tire thread, there's less impact and less injuries.
- You don't get wet and you stay plenty warm!
