### Overview

John Hancock Observatory, one of Chicago's most visited tourist attractions, has launched a state-of-the-art synthetic ice skating rink more than 1,000 feet up on the 94th floor of John Hancock Center. This rink is the perfect place to host your private event; team building exercise, birthday party or corporate event.

### Size

900 square feet (83.6 square meters) or 20 ft. by 45 ft.

### Hours

Open for Private Events January 1, through April 8, 2012, from 9:00 am to 11:00 pm – additional hours available upon request.

### Cost

A two-hour minimum is required on all events at a rate of \$2,500 and \$1,000 for each additional hour. The price includes the ice rink and up to 100 guests. (\$25 per person for each additional guest) Skates will be provided for all guests. Inquire about food and beverage packages.

### More than an Alternative

The synthetic ice is more than an alternative to the real thing it's the closest thing to real ice without the water:

- Skaters feel more confident on it and learn to skate more quickly because they have more stability
- Conventional ice loses gliding ability of up to 10% in only 60 to 90 minutes. Our "ice" doesn't.
- No resurfacing means more "ice time" because the rink never goes out of use.
- With a shore D hardness of 66, or less than a tire thread, there's less impact and less injuries.
- You don't get wet and you stay plenty warm!
